



Dressing Care

It is important to follow all dressing care instructions given to you by your veterinary team to ensure no complications arise.

- Ensure dressings are always kept dry
- Always prevent your pet from interfering with any dressing
- Keep all follow up appointments as advised by your veterinary team
- If the dressing is on a limb, ensure it is always suitably protected when your pet is outside
- Monitor the dressing at least twice a day for signs of complications including foul smell, discharge seeping through, movement of the dressing from original site, swelling above or below the bandage and damage of the dressing.
- If your pet becomes seems distressed by the dressing or has a reduction in appetite or signs of lethargy contact your veterinary practice immediately.
